Brush Up Your Shakespeare

Discover the fun of Shakespeare through period insults, renaissance songs and lively scene work. By exploring sonnets, monologues, and scenes and using script analysis, movement techniques, and other acting tools, students will begin to unlock the power (and fun) of Shakespeare's plays. Students will present work fit for The Globe on the last day of class.

During this session students will partner with the instructor to create their own jukebox musical scene.
