Our 2017-18 School for the Arts season saw great success in the growth of youth in the arts. Year-round programming welcomed over 400 students, and our School for the Arts and bug in a rug performances brought more than 2,500 patrons through our doors. Our school educated over 1200 students at off-site locations through after-school classes, in-class workshops, high interest days, and Girl Scout/Boy Scout workshops. Our bug in a rug series performed for 15,000+ children in more than 80 traveling performances.

Thanks to generous grant funding from the Woman's Club of Wisconsin and donations from School families, we were able to offer in-school drama classes, a bug in a rug JR experience, and a student audience performance of our two Junior Musicals.

I am proud to report all of these fantastic numbers for our School for the Arts. But more importantly, we are proud of the experiences Sunset is able to provide to students everywhere. I, the teaching staff, and professional performers work hard to inspire a new generation of theater patrons, volunteers, and participants. 
ADVERTISE IN A SUNSET PROGRAM
