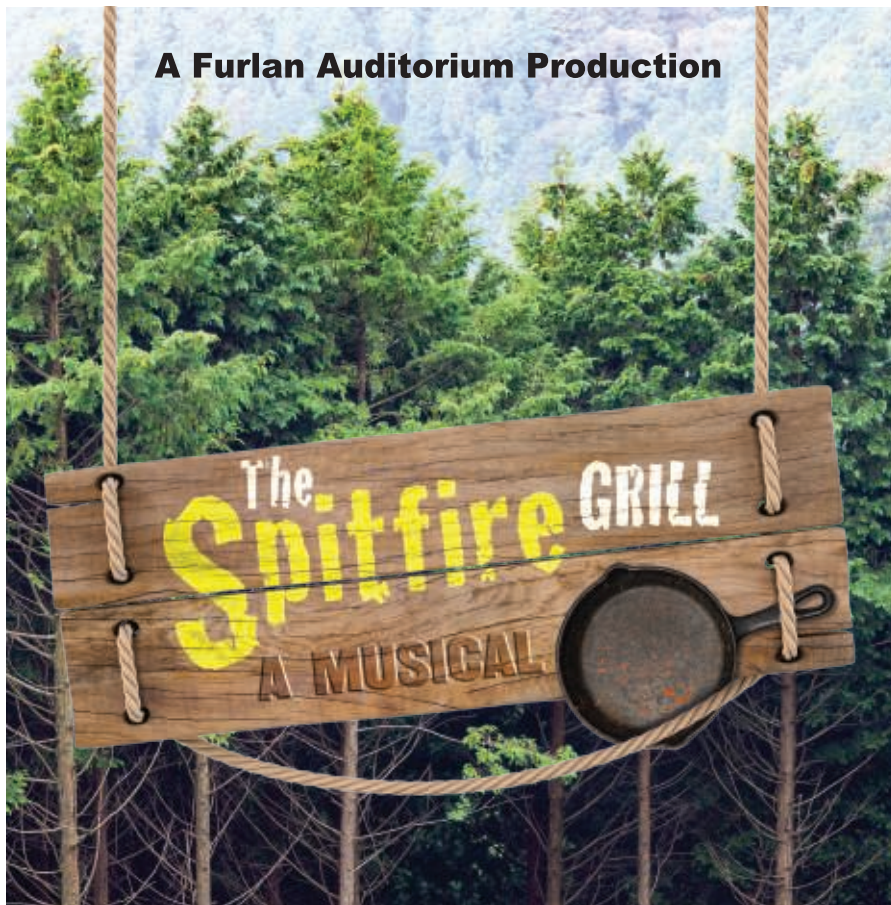

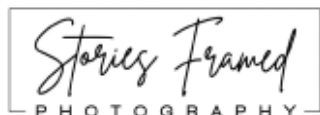
Tuesday - Friday 1 PM - 5 PM and open 1 hour prior to any performance for purchase of tickets for that evening's show. 262-782-4430.
