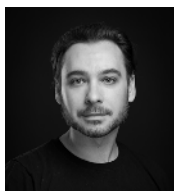

MIKE J. VAN DRESER (Lighting Design)

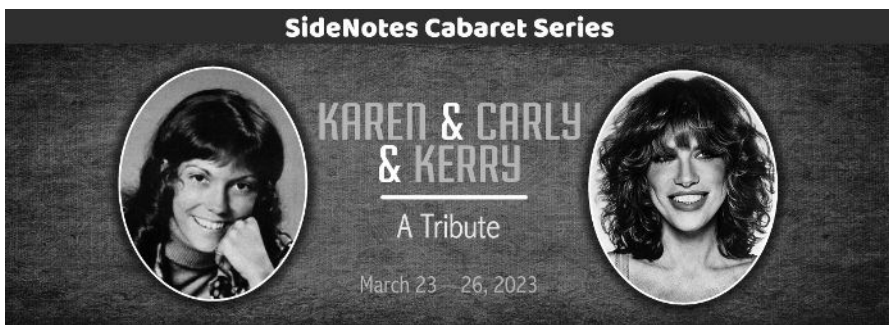
