I'm sure you'll agree that returning to Sunset for our 2021-22 season was especially exciting after Covid cancelled our 2020-21 productions!

We welcomed you back with the hilarious RUN FOR YOUR WIFE, had you on the edge of your seat with WAIT UNTIL DARK, celebrated the holidays with SHE LOVES ME, visited Vegas and New York with 4 WEDDINGS AND AN ELVIS and BAREFOOT IN THE PARK, roared with laughter during SOMETHING ROTTEN, were surprised by AN INSPECTOR CALLS and finally, seized the day with NEWSIES. We were Super Troupers with Musical MainStage's ABBA & FRIENDS and were Broadway Belters during the SideNotes BROADWAY BLOCKBUSTER Cabaret.

At Sunset Playhouse, the 2021-22 season meant non-stop productions and the offerings were varied, exciting, and not-to-be-missed! Taking necessary CDC precautions, our Furlan Auditorium hosted an array of memorable productions, Musical MainStage Concerts, and School for the Arts Junior musicals, while our Marla Eichmann Studio Theater offered SideNotes Cabarets, bug in a rug and School of the Arts performances, and many Special Events. In total, our patrons enjoyed four musicals, four plays, three junior musicals, half a dozen Musical MainStage Concerts, six SideNotes Cabarets, two bug in a rug children's shows, three kids' musicals, as well as several exciting, unique events. No other theater in the Midwest can claim so many productions in one season!

Also, this summer we did it! We paid off Sunset's mortgage! In March of 2017 we began our Erase-the-Mortgage campaign with a mortgage of \$588,774. Five years later, thanks to our generous donors and additional contributions from our operating funds, we were able to completely pay off the mortgage in the summer of 2022 – even with a pandemic!

Finally, Sunset continues to actively seek and welcome new volunteers and members. We hope you will continue to be part of the Playhouse and encourage your friends and family to join the Sunset family.

Remember, *Entertainment Begins at Sunset*, and I hope to see you during our 2022-23 season when we will be celebrating our 63rd Season with wonderful productions and many special events!

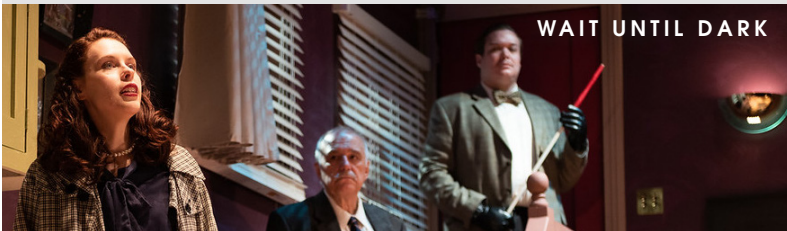

Dear Sunset Stars:

The arts teach students innumerable lessons — practice makes progress, small differences can have large effects, collaboration leads to creativity. The arts also teach children that there are several paths to take when approaching problems and that all problems can have more than one solution. And let's face it — the arts inspire children to use their imaginations, to play and have fun!

The mission of Sunset Playhouse includes an emphasis on education. Our renowned School for the Arts has been educating and entertaining children for more than fifty years. We nurture self-confidence, encourage collaboration, and value each student who participates in our programs as a unique individual.

Our 2021-22 season welcomed students back to the theater with open arms after our shift in programming during the global pandemic. It was a year of adjustment and reinvention. Fall and Winter Session programming welcomed more than 85 students. Our robust summer camps provided 30 options with over 325 students participating. This season we produced three JR and two KIDS Musical productions, resulting in full performance opportunities for more than 200 students. When circumstances once again allowed field trips to the theater, grant funding enabled us to offer a student audience performance of one of our JR Musicals free of charge to area elementary and middle school students.

This winter and spring we were finally able to bring our bug in a rug Children's Theater to life again, performing for more than 6,000 children at over 40 traveling performances. Three Junior and two Kids musicals brought more than 1,500 patrons through our doors. The Sundays at Sunset *Broadway's Best* Cabaret showcased 11 local high school students singing their favorite show tunes.

In this year of rejuvenation, I am proud to report all these fantastic numbers for our School for the Arts. But more importantly, we are proud of the experiences Sunset is able to provide for so many young people. I, along with the teaching staff and professional performers, work hard to inspire a new generation of theater patrons, volunteers, and participants. In a time when technology has become a huge part of our life experience, I am proud that Sunset provides vibrant opportunities for students to connect in person, use their imagination, take risks, and build confidence.
