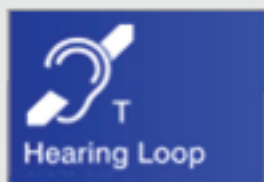
Bipolar Ionization System at Sunset!

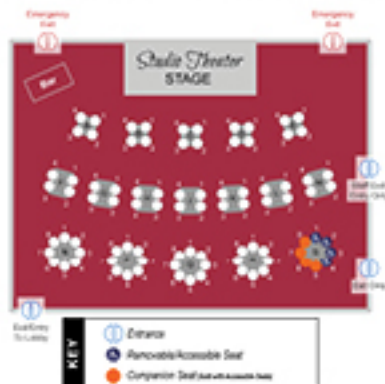

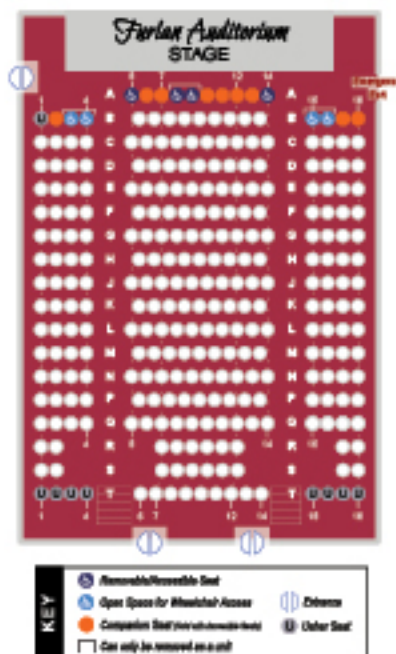
